

CIRCLE OF SERVICE AWARD

The Circle of Service is a symbol of service to the square dance world. It is designed to be worn with PRIDE by dancers who, for three or more years are determined to have made a significant contribution to the square and round dance movement.

The stellar hub of the Circle, formed by a pattern of arcs, symbolizes the importance of each such individual to the total picture. The same circular shapes flow outward to help define interlocking squares and stylized musical symbols. This linear interplay suggests the strong bond between the two "sister" dance activities Square & Round Dancing.

Presentation of the circle of service should be made to dancers only, as in "I'm just a dancer". Those presenting the Circle must have themselves been the recipients at an earlier date. We urge the presentation be made at a suitable gathering.
